This new unique platform promotes cultural exchange and cooperation between the Nordic countries and the Arab world with a focus on film.


MMF will be held 3rd to 5th of October 2015 in area of the Sankt Gertrud Conference Center. Malmö.

The City of Malmö is proud to be the home of MAFF Malmö Arab Film Festival fl a festival that has quickly developed into to Europe's most important festival of films from the Arab world.

MAFF Malmö Arab Film festival is one of three important Öpillarså in the city's annual film calendar together with BUFF (The International Children and Young People's Film Festival) in the spring and Nordisk Panorama - Nordic Short and Doc Film Festival, in the fall right before MAFF.

Malmö is a young, global, modern and creative city with a mixed population of 320 000 inhabitants of about 170 nationalities.

The City of Malmö is aiming to establish a film fund and towards becoming a film friendly city with the intent of welcoming many film productions in the future.



ABOUT

The Danish Film Institute (DFI) is DenmarkÖs national agency for film and cinema culture, operating under the Ministry of Culture. It supports the development, production and distribution of films and runs the national archives. In addition, it offers a number of services to the public, including a cinemathèque, library, bookshop, and an interactive film workshop for children and young people. The DFI allocates subsidies for the development, production and distribution of Danish films as well as international co-productions. Support programmes also extend to film education and international promotion at film festivals. The DFI includes a library, a stills and posters archive and a film archive. The DFI Film House is open to the public and houses the National Cinemathèque. An important task of the DFI is to provide a framework for film funding, which promotes diversity and the desire to take risks in the industry. 
In 2014 LAFF decided to start its ETISAL Fund which aims to support the uprising 18 to 30 years old African filmmakers, who currently live in Africa, to produce their films. ETISAL shared by 60000 \$ in a new fund with full amount of 100.000 USD to support these filmmakers to overcome their challenges and realize their creativity. Until now ETISAL signed more than 33 protocols of collaboration with different funders including production houses, festivals, individuals, TV and radio stations, to create a new platform for African Film Mart. Supporting production, promotion and distribution of African films, using modern digital technology and setting up a database for African films. In this context ETISAL produced 6 shorts from Rwanda, Ethiopia, Togo, Ivory Coast and Egypt. STEP program of ETISAL film fund is now working on development of 5 long narrative projects with financing 3 of them in the pre-production phase, from Egypt, Rwanda and Madagascar.

Film i Skåne is a regional centre for film with the task of promoting all aspects of films. Commissioned and financed by Region Skåne, Film i Skåne has been in operation since 1995. Since 2009, Film i Skåne AB is part of Business Region Skåne.

Our regional film work is run in three main fields Ø Film Education, Screening and Production, Ystad Studios and Southern Sweden Film Commission. We take an overall view, which means that we see a progression where film education Ø see, talk about and make films Ø results in the creation of an interested and demanding audience. This audience consists of active visitors to cinemas and media users, who will also be tomorrowäs filmmakers. The creation of meeting places, workshops, festivals and marketplaces inspires both a new form of narrative and the discovery of new distribution opportunities to reach new viewers.

Through the co-production of short, documentary, feature films and TV series, we attract capital that is spent in the region on services, facilities and labour that help develop the audio-visual infrastructure in Skåne. We take an overall view where the development of the audience, film makers and the media industry is a tool for developing the film environment in Skåne.

Skåne and its role in the Öresund Region offers new opportunities for development and for wider alliances. Contacts with various players such as universities, production companies, municipalities and film organisations both inside and outside the region create networks where future-oriented, highly skilled and hi-tech companies can thrive. 

SANAD is the Development and Post-Production Fund of twofour54, providing talented Arab filmmakers with meaningful support towards the development or completion of their narrative and documentary feature-length films. SANAD offers up to 20,000 USD per project for the Development stage and up to 60,000 USD per project for the Post-Production stage with a total fund of 500,000 USD.

SANAD seeks out bold and remarkable projects from both new and established filmmakers with the aim of encouraging intercultural dialogue and artistic innovation, while building stronger networks within the regionäs film industry.

SANAD also offers year-round support and publicity to grantees and their selected projects to help filmmakers connect with potential partners, further funding opportunities and audiences.

Screen Institute Beirut (SIB) initiative started at a point when a critical mass of ambitious and talented documentary filmmakers in the Arab region had few options for realizing their projects. Access to funding and professional equipment for production and post-production was and still is extremely limited considering the size of the region.

In this context SIB Film Fund was created in November 2009 and it was one of two other funds supporting documentaries in the Arab world.

So far the only fund in the Arab world devoted exclusively for documentary, it offers grants for the development, production and post-production of films by emerging and proven talents from the Arab world. Since its launch, SIB Film Fundas vision is to support films that are made with a low and realistic budget.

With three selection rounds per year and an average number of fifteen projects awarded grants every year, SIB has awarded so far 80 grants to projects out of which 30 films are completed and currently in distribution.

The Screen Institute provides additional support to the grantees through workshops, advising and networking opportunities.

The ambition is to make their films visible to large audiences, to ensure and increase the grantees chances of finding local and international distributors to their films Ø and not least to help them find funding for their next projects.





A Tale of a Comedian in a Syrian Tragedy

This documentary çlm is a chronicle of a revolution seen through the eyes of the Syrian actor Fares Helou. His life changed radically when he joined the people in the streets of Damascus calling for the fall of the Syrian regime. Fares Helou immediately had to go underground and director Rami Farah followed him with a camera into hiding. When Fares had to öee from Syria to France Rami followed him again. However, neither the actor nor the director had a script for their new chapter in life — exile. A life full of questions, disappointments and alienation, but also cultural confusion that calls for laughter. An intimate observation of the absurdity of exiled existence.

On Screen Off Record

In September 2012, Yadan crosses the Syrian-Jordanian border on foot, with a hard drive full of dreams and nightmares. Since day one, he has been clming the Syrian uprisings that started in Daraa with four of his friends. This documentary tells the story of cve Syrian activists whose destinies were shaped by the Syrian revolution as it went from being a non-violent movement, to a militarized and an Islamized conöict, to a vicious civil war. They were the local reporters on the ground. We have seen their images on our news programs. This clm will go behind the scene and make us rethink their stories and the media machine they became a part of.
