Malmö Arab Film Festival (MAFF) is the leading and largest film festival dedicated to Arab cinema outside the Arab world. The festival has been held since 2011 and has since then come to provide a platform for Arab cinema in Europe. The starting point for the festival was to create a platform and a meeting place for Arab cinema in Malmö, Sweden and Europe. The festival was founded by the festival's general manager and creative director Mouhamad Keblawi. It started as a grassroots initiative and has since undergone a tremendous development, and is now the largest film festival in southern Sweden. The first edition of the festival clearly showed that there was a great demand for contemporary Arab cinema among the public, and the following two years laid the foundation for the festival. MAFF received great attention, both in Sweden and internationally. The range of films and the number of international guests increased, as well as collaborations with external organizations. The organization is now an all-year-around operation working with special events and festivals across Sweden. Malmo Arab Film Festival is ultimately an organization that promotes diversity and tolerance with cinema as its tool. MAFF TRIBUTES STAR HUSSEIN FAHMY WITH A LIFE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Hussein Fahmy has a tremendous artistic career that extends for more than half a century, from the time he played his first role in the movie "Dalal Al-Masria" directed by Hassan El-Imam in 1970 until his most recent role in the series "Serroh Al-Batie" directed by Khaled Youssef, shown during the current month of Ramadan. Through his career, Fahmy acted in more than two hundred films, series, plays, and radio works, and worked with the top-notch directors of Egyptian cinema, such as Youssef Chahine, Kamal Al-Sheikh, Henry Barakat, Mohamed Khan, and others, in addition to holding various cultural positions, including the presidency of the Cairo International Film Festival for two terms, the first between 1998 and 2001, and the second started in 2022 and continues to this day.



MAHA HAJ

Maha Haj was born in Nazareth in 1970. She graduated from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in English and Arabic literature. Her cinematic experience was derived from her work as an artistic designer in the productions of The Time That Remain by Elia Suleiman, The Attack by Ziad Douairi, as well as On the Hill by Rafael Natjari.

She wrote and directed the short film Oranges (2009) and the documentary Behind These Walls (2010). In 2015 she shot her first feature film Personal Affairs which was selected in 2016 Cannes Film Festival's Official Selection "Un Certain Regard" and critically acclaimed. The film also won the Haifa Film Festival's Best Feature Award in 2016 and the Mediterranean Film Festival of Montpellier's Critics' Award, among others.

HANA SHIHA

Hana Shiha is an Egyptian actress born into an artistic family in Beirut. Her father, Ahmed Shiha, is a renowned Egyptian painter, and her mother, Nadia Zeitoun, encouraged her and her three sisters to pursue creative interests like piano and ballet. Hana's passion for reading began early, and she completed French, British, and Egyptian literature by the age of 16. After studying at the academy of arts, Hana earned a bachelor's degree in acting and directing from the high institute of Dramatic arts. Hana made her debut in "EL BAR EL GHARBI" (2002) and went on to star in "HOB EL BANAT" (2003) and "DARS KHOSOUSY" (2005). However, it wasn't until her breakthrough role in the hit series "EL SABAA WASSAYA" (2014) that Hana gained recognition as a leading lady. In 2014, she also appeared in the movie "BEFORE THE SPRING" and the Egyptian Epic Series "EL ADH: EL KALAM EL MUBAH" (2015). Hana was later cast by renowned filmmaker Mohamed Khan in his feature film "ABL ZAHMET EL SEIF" (2016). She has also co-starred in popular TV shows like "The President's Shadow" and "Eye Witness."



MARINA KOSTOVA

Marina Kostova is an award-winning journalist, one of the leading film critics and reporters in Republic of North Macedonia. She is a founding member and Deputy of Editor in Chief of sdk.mk digital newsroom. She was a founding member and Deputy of Editor in Chief of Vest Daily, at the time the biggest newspaper in the country. She is the president of the Macedonian Section of International Federation of Film Critics – FIPRESCI. She edited the books "Manchevski Monograph", and "Rain - The World About Milcho Manchevski's Before the Rain", as well as the CD-ROM "Macedonia in the New York Times Archives", and published a hybrid collection of short stories "Language is a Strange Beast". She worked on research in films as well. She participated in FIPRESCI critics juries at number of film festivals (Venice, Sarajevo, Istanbul, Thessaloniki, Viennale, Oberhausen, Chemnitz, Mannheim, Cluj-Napoca, Luxembourg among others).



MOHANNAD BAKRI

Mohannad Bakri is the Managing Director of The Royal Film Commission Jordan since 2019. Before the RFC, Bakri was the Director of External Relations and Strategic Partnerships at New York University in Abu Dhabi and was the former Regional Managing Director of Luminus Media Institution – Jordan. Earlier in his career, from 2007 - 2012, he served as the RFC's Capacity Building Manager, where he then largely contributed to developing local and regional training programs.

AHMAD ABDALLA

An Egyptian Filmmaker and part of the new wave of independent cinema in the Arab world. In 2009 he directed his first feature film "Heliopolis" which was one of the first successful independent Egyptian films to be released theatrically in Egypt. Then came his second "Microphone" which was selected among the best 100 Arabic films in history by Dubai Film Festival and won over 20 international awards. He co-directed "18 Days" which was officially selected in Cannes 2011. He then directed "Rags & Tatters" in 2013, "Decor" in 2014, "EXT/Night" 2018. His latest films have been selected in many prestigious film festivals such as Toronto IFF, London BFI, Singapore IFF, São Poulo IFF, and won many awards such as Golden award in Cinemed Mediterranean Film Festival of Montpellier, Golden Tanit in Journées cinématographiques de Carthage, Golden Tulip in Istanbul IFF festival.

Firas Khoury is Palestinian scriptwriter and director. He graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in cinema. Khoury has several short films to his credit; among them are the award-winning movies Seven Days in Deir Bulus (2007) and Yellow Mums (2010). These films were broadcast in festivals around the world but also on TV channels, including Arte and VVD. In 2019 he finished his next short, Maradona's Legs, which has received the Robert Bosch Stiftung Film Prize that year and also the support of Berlin Medienboard. The movie was shown at the Palm Springs Film Festival.



BATATA

SYNOPSIS

2022 Marks the 10th anniversary of the Syrian Refugee Crisis. With over 13 million displaced, it remains the largest human forced migration crisis of our times, but sadly not the last as millions of Ukrainians stream across the border. Shot over anunparalleled 10 years, Syrian-Lebanese director Noura Kevorkian's intimate camera follows the plight of Maria and her family of Syrian migrant workers who find themselves unable to return back to their hometown of Raqqa Syria. Unique among the numerous refugee stories to date, BATATA captures an entire decade while documenting not just the age-old conflict between two nations, but the unbending spirit of a woman who puts family ahead of all else.

Noura Kevorkian

Noura Kevorkian is a Syrian-Lebanese filmmaker. She made her filmmaking debut with the multi-award winning short VEILS UNCOVERED (Official Competition IDFA), followed by the feature documentary ANJAR: FLOWERS, GOATS AND HEROES, and the drama-doc hybrid film 23 KILOMETRES (Official Competition Karlovy Vary).

Noura divides her time living between Lebanon and Canada.


AHMED YASSIN AL DARADJI



SYNOPSIS

When Nicole reveals to her childhood friend and cousin, Reine, that she's been addicted to heroin since she was 13, they decide to document Nicole's rehab journey. Hyphen follows the ups and downs of their relationship as well as Nicole's struggle to move out into the world as an adult and grown woman despite the lack of economic opportunities and a poisonous cultural upbringing that teaches young women to suppress their ideas and sexuality and to follow a set of religious and cultural rules.

NEZOUH

SYNOPSIS

The film takes place during the Syrian conflict, when a missile destroys the ceiling of the house of 14-year-old Zeina. As a result, she sleeps for the first time under the stars and makes friends with Amer – the boy next door.

When the violence escalates, Hala – Zeina's mother – decides to leave. She then gets into an argument with her husband, Motaz, who refuses to become a refugee and tries everything to stop his family from leaving their house.

SOUDADE KAADAN




In 2014, he began making short films. Two of which are on Netflix, '27th of Shaban' and 'Curtain' as part of the Six Windows in the Desert film collection.

Through the director's mother's lens we explore the dual stories of a mother navigating the impossible choice of whether to take her family away from home amidst immense danger, trading physical safety for emotional turmoil, and the story of a mother and son navigating the impact this unspoken time had on their family for the first time. It explores questions of: why she filmed them; why it took so long to leave as danger intensified around them; and, whether she would make that same decision again. Structured around the three promises Suha negotiates with God as Palestine's Second Intifada escalates, the film is an intimate portrait of how four family members experience crisis and the roles they play within the family unit. What unfolds might be surprising. The film is peppered with moments of humor, real-time deliberation around how to get to safety, and the heartbreaking witness of a son losing his grasp on childhood.








In doing so, MID positions Malmö and the Skåne region as a hub for film production and brings together representatives from all the major Nordic film institutes.

The Skåne region has developed into a vibrant center for film production and other creative industries, with numerous new organizations, production companies, and enterprises that have boosted the city's economic capacity and enhanced its appeal, both nationally and internationally. MAFF Industry Days offers a unique platform to showcase this development and promote cross-cultural exchange between the film industries of Sweden and the Arab world.

BOOK SIGNING CEREMONY

WOMEN, THE FUTURE OF ARAB CINEMA

Two scenes! Two scenes put the story into frame. Ninety years separate these two very real scenes despite their "cinematic" nature. The first scene heralded the true beginning of Egyptian cinema, The Mother of Arab Cinema. The second marked the loftiest award that Arab Cinema had granted, to the same being who starred in the first scene. The first scene took place in Cairo, specifically in The Metropole Cinema on November 16, 1927 after the premiere of the film Layla. Turkish Widad Orfa started making it, then Stephan Rosti, whose origins are Greek, took over and finished the film. Aziza Amir produced the film and starred in it thereby being considered a pioneer of the true Egyptian Cinema dubbed thereafter "Hollywood on the Nile". In that foundational moment, which will be representative of the birth of Egyptian cinema for decades to come, it was really significant that Talaat Harb, the most prominent economist in Egypt during that time, should stand and applaud, not the directors of the film, but that woman whose presence was key to the coming-into-life of Egyptian Cinema, Aziza Amir, the producer and the lead actress of the film. When Talaat Harb addressed her, with Ahmed Chawki next to him endorsing his words, he said, "I congratulate you, madam, for you have fulfilled, as a woman, what men couldn't."

Talaat Harb was well known for the way he meticulously embellished his words with his "Egyptian" perception, distinguishing thereby the Egyptian producer from her foreign colleagues. He was undoubtedly congratulating the woman in Aziza Amir and praising the role she played, as a woman, in that cinematic coming-into-life. ...

As for the second scene, which came more than ninety years after the Cairo scene, it was in the city of Tunis, specifically during one of the latest distinguished sessions in the history of that festival, the 2019 edition. One of its great surprises and features is that Arab women filmmakers won about two-thirds of the awards. They made up more than three-quarters of the people working in the festival as well as of the audience of the more serious films and the important educational sessions and debates, which are the trademark of this festival. It is true that this edition of Carthage did not bring anything new, since the large female presence is characteristic of the serious film festivals such as the Malmö Arab Film Festival in Sweden. All this gives the two scenes with which we began our work their flavor and significance, and gives this book, which is, first and foremost, devoted to the cinema of Arab women, or more significantly to the women of Arab cinema, a raison d'âtre....

IBRAHIM ALARISS



The" Voices Amplified" project, aims to provide aspiring filmmakers across Jordan with the opportunity to express their lives'experiences through producing short narrative films themed "Cultural Heritage". The project aims to build the filmmaking capabilities of Jordanians and residents in Jordan through the different stages from script development to post-production, all under the supervision of professionals from Sweden and Jordan. This project is important as it empowers filmmakers in Jordan to represent their reality and take control of their own stories.

FINDING OUM AL GHAITH

Following the story of three Women (A semi-nomadic, an Urban and a Bedouin) before winter solace in a drought land, leading their community to save water resourcing. Contrasting and echoing ancient rainmaking rituals connected to a folkloric character (Oum Al-Ghaith). (Oum Al-Ghaith) is also a ritual performed by the Bedouins in the event of the lack of rain, where children would create a wooden sculpture of (Oum Al-Ghaith) and sing folkloric songs asking for the much-needed rain. The Film illustrates this fictional character by showing our main Three "human" characters and the role each of them plays in leading their community in saving water resources, only to find that they are our own real-life (Oum Al-Ghaith) and they inspire a new generation of resource protectors.

SHE IS SOUF

"Souf" is a short documentary that tells the story of Najah Al-Azza, a resident of a former refugee camp in Souf, Jerash. Born to Palestinian parents who fled Palestine in 1948, Najah faced numerous challenges including poverty, family tragedy, and discrimination due to her dark skin color. Despite this, she defied the odds and ran for parliamentary elections, excelled in her studies, and achieved her dreams. The film culminates with Najah passing the flag of hope to her nephew Elias, who represents a bright future for her community.

He has attended courses in documentary filmmaking and made several short documentaries, including "Third Eye on Madaba," which won Best Short Documentary at a French Cultural Institute competition. Lafi has also worked as an assistant director on documentaries for Al Jazeera and AlAraby Television, including "Naya Group," "Churchill's Memoirs," and "Palestinian Cinema" directed by Nader Taha, Aroa Hamad Allah, and Ayed Nabaa.
